Take Advantage of the 2015 School Tax Credit

Arizona law, A.R.S. 43-1089.01, allows Arizona taxpayers to receive a tax credit for donations that benefit students in our schools. By law, only donations to extracurricular activities that charge a fee qualify for the tax credit. Donations can be directed toward a specific activity that supports Fine Arts, Athletics, and other K-12 extracurricular activities and our character education programs; or you may specify that your donation is a contribution that benefits all children.

All Arizona tax payers are eligible: you do not have to have a child enrolled at ASDB to benefit from this law.

Just choose to pay some of the state income tax you owe to support children directly. Total amount cannot exceed \$400 for a joint tax return and \$200 for an individual return.

Best of all, you get your tax credit contribution back--all of it--when you participate during the 2014 year and file your tax return.

Extracurricular activities are school sponsored activities that require enrolled students to pay a fee in order to participate. Such activities may include, but are not limited to, use of equipment or uniforms for varsity athletics, use of scientific laboratory equipment or materials, or in-state or out-of state trips that are solely for competitive events. Extracurricular activities do not include any senior trips or events that are recreational, amusement or tourist activities. Generally, any educational or recreational activities that supplement the educational program of the school are considered to be extracurricular activities. A.R.S. § 15-342.24 requires each district school board to determine which activities are extracurricular and what fees will be levied.

A character education program is a program defined in A.R.S. § 15-719. Under this statute each district may develop its own course of study for each grade. At a minimum, the character education program must include instruction in the definition and application of at least six of the following character traits: truthfulness, responsibility, compassion, diligence, sincerity, trustworthiness, respect, attentiveness, obedience, orderliness, forgiveness and virtue.
